**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED  
RULES RELATING TO PERMITS ISSUED BY THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF FILM,  
THEATRE & BROADCASTING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN** the Commissioner of the Mayor's Office Film, Theatre & Broadcasting, pursuant to sections 389(b) and 1043 of the New York City Charter, that the Mayor's Office of Film Theatre & Broadcasting ("MOFTB") intends to amend Title 43 of the Official Compilation of Rules of the City of New York, governing the issuance of permits in connection with scouting, rigging and production activities. Matter underlined is new. The proposed amendments are set forth below.

Written comment regarding this proposed amendment may be sent to MOFTB's Communications Department, 1697 Broadway, New York NY 10019, on or before December 13, 2007. Comments may be submitted electronically to such Department at [message@film.nyc.gov](mailto:message@film.nyc.gov).

A public hearing will be held on December 13, 2007, at the offices of the Economic Development Corporation, 110 William Street, 4th floor (between Fulton and John Streets) at 10:00 AM. Persons seeking to testify are requested, but not required, to notify the MOFTB the foregoing address not less than five (5) days prior to the hearing. Written comments and a summary of oral comments received at the hearing will be available for public inspection, within a reasonable time after receipt, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., at the offices of MOFTB.

Persons who request that a sign language interpreter or other form of reasonable accommodation for a disability be provided at the hearing are asked to notify the MOFTB at the foregoing address by December 11, 2007.

The proposed rule was not included in the Department's regulatory agenda because the changes to be established by the rule were not anticipated at the time the regulatory agenda was to be published.

This rule was initially published for comment in the City Record on May 25, 2007 and a hearing was held on June 28, 2007. MOFTB extended the comment period through August 3, 2007, and having reviewed comments received, is hereby submitting proposed rules that include revisions of what were previously published.
